Introduction

During 1975 - 1981 Uranus was transiting the sign of Scorpio. On June 5th, 1981, the United States Centres for Disease Control issued its first warning about a relatively rare form of pneumonia among a small group of young gay men in Los Angeles, which was later determined to be AIDS-related.

While 1981 is generally referred to as the beginning of the HIV/AIDS epidemic, scientists believe that HIV was present years before the first cases were brought to public attention.

RARE CANCER SEEN IN 41 HOMOSEXUALS

Outbreak Occurs Among Men
in New York and California
—8 Died Inside 2 Years

Doctors in New York and California have diagnosed among homosexual men 41 cases of a rare and often rapidly fatal form of cancer. Eight of the victims died less than 24 months after the diagnosis was made.

The cause of the outbreak is unknown, and there is as yet no evidence of contagion. But the doctors who have made the diagnoses, mostly in New York City and the San Francisco Bay area, are alerting other physicians who treat large numbers of homosexual men to the problem in an effort to help identify more cases and to reduce the delay in offering chemotherapy treatment.

GENERAL CORRESPONDENCE

Physiological Signs

Ari - Head, skull, face (eruptions), eyes, cerebrum, brain tissue, cerebral nervous system, consciousness, aggression, and arousal.

Tau - Upper respiratory, cerebellum, lower jaw, throat, tonsils, voice (pharynx and vocal cords), ears (Eustachian tubes and middle ear), thyroid (heart through the thyroid centre), and neck.

Gem - Middle respiratory, breathing, bronchial tubes, lungs, all body tubes, nerves (nervous disorders), chest, shoulders, arms, hands, and fingers. Fibres and filaments. Thymus gland? Capillaries?

Can - Lower respiratory, pleura, all mucous and serous membranes, saliva and chyme, digestive organs, stomach (digestive juices), and breasts (breast milk). Glycogen storage in the liver? (Davidson also suggests eyeballs, bone marrow (red blood cell problems), cheeks, ovaries, posterior pituitary gland and its hormones)?

Leo - Heart, large blood vessels, circulatory system (blood pressure), back, spine, immune system, and eyes (retina).

Vir - Sympathetic nervous system (nervous disorders), solar plexus, diaphragm (breathing), liver (filtering function of the liver), digestive enzymes, spleen, gall-bladder, pancreas, duodenum, and intestines (small).

Lib - Kidneys (maintenance of electrolyte balance through kidney filtration), regulates body temperature (and other homeostatic mechanisms), and lumbar region. Balance of body fluids.

Sco - Colon (and all eliminative body channels, including nose, sweat glands, and defecation), uterus, genitals (procreative system - arousal, fertilisation, to birth), the urinary system from the kidney pelvis to the urethra, including the ureters and the bladder), prostate, groins, rectum, excretory organs - endocrines (suprarenals (adrenal glands), ovaries, testicles), and lower back.

Sag - Hips, thighs, blood vessels, locomotion and the lower spinal cord, lumbar region, muscles, muscular system, peritoneum, bladder muscle, ability of the eye to focus, and left cerebral hemisphere.

Cap - Knees, joints, bones (the dense structures of the body), skin, mucous membranes, cell tissues, anterior pituitary gland (regulatory functions), gall-bladder, calcium metabolism, and anti-peristaltic movement.

Aqu - Calves, shins, ankles, blood circulation, corticospinal tract, and cellular oxidation (cellular respiration).

Pis - Feet (reflex zone therapy), calcaneus (heel bone), toes, fibres, tendons, lymph and lymphatics, production of mucus and phlegm, and synovia (joint fluid). Hospitals and institutions. Auto immune system? Allergies?

Planets of Global Influence

URANUS

LIFE-PRINCIPLE: Deviation, through invention, independence, drastic change.

PHYSIOLOGICALLY: Uranus seems to be particularly associated with the sympathetic nervous system. Disease and disorders connected with the planet's function are of primarily nervous origin, often appearing unexpectedly. Is associated with mental disorders of a very excitable and convulsive nature. Sudden nervous breakdowns, hysteria, abnormal or freak growth, all forms of spasms, cramps, paralysis, palpitation are attributable to Uranus, activated with other factors. The change of life in both sexes is closely linked with the Moon, Saturn, and Uranus cycles. In the early-forties both the progressed Moon and transiting Saturn for the second time, and transiting Uranus for the first time, oppose their respective positions in the natal chart (of each one of us). Moon and Uranus are associated with functional changes, whilst Saturn significantly determines the time scheduled for this critical readjustment of the whole physical organism and Psyche. It is noteworthy that at this stage in life the sympathetic nervous system seems to be more unstable than is normal. The Uranus principle may well correspond to the pineal body and gonads (sex glands) of the endocrine system. The pineal is thought to be the remnant of a 'third eye' referred to in ancient writings and drawings. Occultists claim it is the source of, 'seer-ship' (spiritual vision) and psychic clairvoyance. The pineal is said to be a communicating centre between the brain and the other organs, and tumours in this gland produce accelerated sexual development. Homosexuality and sexual perversions are connected with Uranus.

PSYCHOLOGICALLY: The urge to deviate from the normal. When we think of Uranus as the first planet beyond the boundary traced by Saturn's orbit we may see a clue to the symbology of Uranus. It represents a breakaway force from the rigidly controlled normal organism. It is revolt, anarchy, a

sudden dramatic flash of genius. It is intuition, an unexpected insight to a yet unborn future design. It may be Nature's way to ensure the creation of entirely new features and disrupt life out of its cyclic rut of accepted order and limitations. Through this disruptive impulse springs originality, creative inspiration, scientific thought, inventiveness, the urge for independence and freedom of expression, image-forming power, altruism, unorthodox, rebellious or reformative impulses, free and illicit sexual behaviour, the urge to make drastic changes from the normal. Afflictions to Uranus suggest a tendency for irresponsible, eccentric, violent, perverted, fanatical, depraved, or simply peculiar behaviour.

NEPTUNE

LIFE-PRINCIPLE: Refinement, through dissolution, subtlety, immateriality, sensitivity.

PHYSIOLOGICALLY: The Neptune principle seems particularly associated with the thalamus, the spinal canal and the nervous and mental processes generally. The thalamus is a part of the brain from which optic and hearing nerves spring; it has nervous connections with the pituitary gland. In fact, the thalamus has been called the conductor of the pituitary (rhythms of growth) whereby the whole of the endocrine system is coordinated. Botanically thalamus means the receptacle of a flower (think of the Neptune symbol), derived from the Greek thalamus, an inner or secret chamber (typically Neptunian). Of similar origins we find thalassic means 'of the sea' (Neptune affinity); thallus, a vegetable structure from which true roots are absent (symbolised by the sea the Neptune function has no roots materially, is the non-confined, the dissolver of form) which includes algae, fungi and lichens (traditionally associated with Neptune). An afflicted Neptune is invariably found in the charts of those who suffer from mysterious illnesses, severe mental or emotional disturbance, or the incurably insane, and always where there is a deep-rooted neurosis. Neptune's correspondence is with one of the subtle and most 'refined' forces working within the mind and body of man.

PSYCHOLOGICALLY: The urge through the sensory mechanisms and the most sensitive perceptive faculties to seek experience beyond and detached from all material form and structure. Its function stimulates the nervous and emotional responses to an extreme pitch of sensitivity and excitement. It is an essential link with the 'invisible realms of inspiration' for the brilliant composer and musician, poet, painter, religious leader it is the subtle and powerful disintegrator, source of hallucinations and hysteria, in the mentally deranged; the link with the spiritual energies outside of man, or with the deceptive forces of the unconscious mind, which create the trance and psychic conditions of spiritual mediums; and is the process working through both hypnotist and hypnotised. It develops impressionability, idealism, artistic sensitivity unwieldiness', day-dreaming, mystical experiences, love of the sea intensely religious or humanistic feelings. When Neptune is strong in a chart, drugs, sedatives, alcohol should be taken with discretion. Afflictions to Neptune suggest a tendency to woolly-headedness, escapism self-deception or flagrant dishonesty, impracticality and generally confused and chaotic handling of one's life, vagueness, hypersensitivity, sensationalism, obsessional fears, and risk of poisoning, gassing, drowning It is the subtle architect of chaos, fantasy, self-disintegration, illusion, and despair through the hidden yet potent forces of the unconscious in ourselves, which tempts escape into degrading drinking and sexual orgies and perversions, neuroses, suicide, and homosexuality.

PLUTO

LIFE-PRINCIPLE: Transformative, through elimination, renewal.

PHYSIOLOGICALLY PLUTO: Seems to be associated with the creative and regenerative forces in the body, involving cell-formation and the reproductive function. This does not mean Pluto alone is connected with these, but that it would seem to correspond to an essential mediating role for the use of these physical re-creative forces for the mental processes. Thus, correspondence with the gonads, and mental processes, and afflictions to Pluto suggest possible disorders or disease through these.

PSYCHOLOGICALLY PLUTO: Corresponds to a process of subterranean activities deep within the unconscious, like the deepest roots of a tree which are essential for bringing to the surface necessary elements both for nourishment and for release through the leaves. It is a dual role of elimination and renewal, physically and psychologically. Its process forces 'out into the open', into consciousness, a problem, the root cause of a neurosis, or a revealing truth, that has been long hidden and yet unconsciously agitating the mind, which the system can no longer contain in its existing form. It has to be completely eliminated or transformed Pluto corresponds to the critical phase in the cycle of life-force, or any process or activity, where death or the bringing to an end is inevitable that rebirth or a new beginning can occur. It is associated with the forces which initiate colossal business enterprises and combines, mass hysteria, mob lynching, political blood-purges. Psychologically it is the Whole Self in opposition to a particular discordant or unnecessary feature. An afflicted Pluto suggests possible 'difficulty in elimination', hence suppression of unpleasant feelings with consequent risk of obsessional and neurotic conditions, and in severe cases probable eruptive outbursts of violence or self-destruction.
